## **Approval of Minutes:**

## **Treasurers Report:**

CD \$11,996.63, Checking \$23,350.36 No liabilities. The cost of Fun on the Water this year was estimated to be \$2500. Motion to approve by and seconded. Discussion of expenditures and coverage by grant dollars.

## **Speaker Dr. Randy Lehr**

Dr. Lehr from Northland College discussed Lake Management Grants. He discussed the issue of cisco in the lake found first in 2015 and requirement for higher lake quality. Discussed implications and role of DNR with the identification of cisco in the lake, requirements to meet lake quality measures, and sources of phosphorus introduction into the lake. Additional discussion ensued related to the stable quality of the waters of Lake Namekagon and how the presence of cisco changes requirements, not that the lake quality has changed.

He also discussed NLA sponsorship of student researcher in the future and opportunities for involvement.

## **Accomplishments 2015-2016**

Were reviewed at the meeting. These included membership, AIS monitoring including cameras, review of videos, boat landing supervision, buoy management, lake shore clean up, fun on the water, identification of milfoil and management as well as plans for the volunteer appreciation dinner.

**Election Process:**

Nominees – Amanda Staudemeyer and Jim DeRoma were introduced. There were no additional nominees from the floor.

**New Business:**

- Milfoil found in Lakewood's Marina June 2016 – issues related to the discovery and management discussed. 2 pullings done. Andy Teal leading the hand pulls. Additional assessments done with DNR looking for spread and additional sources of milfoil, assessment of other boat landings negative for milfoil.

- By-Law Changes – suggested by-law changes were discussed with the membership and after review/membership voted to accept the three by-law changes suggested by NLA Board
- Amanda Staudemeyer and Jim De Roma were elected to the Board.
